The Aerodrome understands the financial strains placed on large families when thinking about registering their children into recreational activities. We are extremely proud that we can offer families who have three or more registrants from the same **immediate family offering 35% discount** on EACH of the skaters in the family. This includes Mom and Dad as well!

How to get your Family Discount:

You must receive a discount code before registering online. Aerodrome will send out a discount code to families who wish to participate in this offer. The code can be used only ONE time.

Once you have your discount code go to the registration page at www.Aerodromes.com and set up your account and make your class selections. When the correct discount code has been input you will see a notice of **Discount Applied**. No other discounts are allowed to be used in conjunction with the family Discount. 35% discount is based on the original fee. Families of less than three cannot use this offer.

IMPORTANT NOTE: THE FAMILY DISCOUNT IS AVAILABLE ONLY FOR SKATERS WHO PARTICIAPTE IN THE LEARN TO SKATE PROGRAMS.

Private Lessons Available!

Aerodrome also offer private lessons to skaters either to supplement their Learn To Skate classes, or booked on an individual basis. Private lesson fees range from **\$30.00 to \$44.00 for 30 minutes**. All our coaches have at least basic coaching qualifications based on the PSA (Professional Skaters Association). Generally speaking the most experienced coaches charge higher lesson rates.

Please note that our coaches are independent contractors so payment is made directly to the coach. Also the advertised price of the private lesson does not include the cost of entering the ice session and therefore the rink admission fee must also be purchased.

We suggest that you first consider taking a lesson from your group class coach however this is definitely not mandatory. For help finding a private coach speak to Taunya Blanco or Mark Poole. We will be happy to assist you.

Make-up Classes & Refund Policy

The Aerodrome wants you and your children to enjoy your time with us. If you miss a class you are welcome to schedule a 'make-up class' on another day **within the same semester**. Make up classes must be made up within the semester and make-ups cannot be carried forwards to a new semester.

However if you cannot continue with your classes for whatever reason we will be happy to pro-rate or refund.

All refunds are charged a \$25.00 administration fee





Learn to Skate Frequently Asked Questions

What do I wear?

Whether skating indoors or outdoors, dress for warmth by layering your clothing. Most indoor arenas are kept between 30 and 50 degrees, so jackets are recommended. As you get warm, you may wish to discard a layer. Comfort and ability to move freely are also very important. We suggest close-fitting but not tight pants. Sweatpants or warm-up pants are ideal. Your feet will feel best if you wear one pair of lightweight socks or tights. Bulky or thick socks may limit the support provided by your skates and create "bumps" inside your boots, making them uncomfortable. Make sure when fitting your skates that your toes can wiggle but your heel does not slide up and down or around once your foot is properly laced in the skate.

Remember gloves or mittens! Learning to fall is an important part of ice skating, and your hands will feel much better if you are wearing gloves or mittens. If you forget to bring them along with you, the Aerodrome sells gloves in the pro shop.

Check-in Table

Please be sure to check-in at the blue **every week**. This helps us keep track of make-ups and any class changes.

Evaluations and Evaluation Forms

Evaluations normally start in the 4th week of a semester in which the skaters will be evaluated on the skills they have been taught. Evaluations can take between 2-3 weeks to complete depending on the length of the semester and/or the size of the class. Evaluation Forms will be handed out to the skaters on the last day of your skater's class. This will have notes from their coach and let you know what class to register for the next semester.

Make-up policy

If you miss your class you can make up on another day that we offer the same class level. Ex: You will be missing week 6, you can make up on week 2 or week 7. Whatever works best with your schedule. However, only during the same semester that you are currently in rolled in. You may not make up a class from the previous semester. Special circumstances are up to our LTS coordinator Taunya Blanco.
